MINISTERIAL ORDER

Series of 1968, No. 11

REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE PRACTICE OF NURSING

Section 1. Title

The Board of Nursing, created by Executive Order No. 125, Series of 1961, and as amended, and the Board of Examiners for Nurses, created by Executive Order No. 126, Series of 1961, and as amended, are hereby authorized to promulgate and enforce the following regulations governing the practice of nursing in the Philippines:

SECTION 2. Short Title

ARTICLE III - GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 1. Definition of Terms

As used in these regulations, the following terms shall mean:

(a) "Board" shall mean the Board of Nursing and the Board of Examiners for Nurses.

(b) "Nurse" shall mean a person who has graduated from a school of nursing and has been registered with the Board.

(c) "Nursing" shall mean the practice of nursing as defined in these regulations.

(d) "Nursing Practice Act" shall mean the Act creating the Board of Nursing and the Board of Examiners for Nurses.
